




ECU Headcount Enrollment: Fall Semesters




Freshman Application and Matriculation









Major Findings

- The number of freshman applications is trending up, while the yield rate remains low. Yield rates for Eastern NC counties are higher.
- Compared to non-enrolled students, students enrolled at ECU tended to have lower HS GPAs and test scores, and were more likely to be rural or low-income students.
- UNC sister schools remain ECU's largest competitors. In 2019, NC State surpassed UNC Charlotte to become ECU's largest competitor.
- Over 1/3 of UNC Wilmington's freshman class in 2019 was also accepted by ECU; for ASU, the proportion was 23%.



Major Findings (Cont'd)


- Wake Tech, Central Piedmont, Cape Fear and Pitt are the top community college competitors of ECU.
- Tuition deposit and orientation attendance were highly predictive of freshman enrollment.
- Very few students who paid a tuition deposit and attended orientation did not enroll. Some of them attended a community college, and others were not in the National Student Clearinghouse.
- Yield rates, student profiles, and major competitors varied across programs. A considerable number of non-enrolled students entered the same program at their destination school as they had intended to enter at ECU.








Top Feeder Schools: Yield Rate Comparison

Deposit and Orientation: Fall 2019

Major Findings:

- 14% of the students who paid tuition deposit but did not enroll at ECU.
- 9% of students who both paid tuition deposit and attended orientation did not enroll at ECU.
 - Of them, 45% were not in the National Student Clearinghouse.

Major Findings

- For 2 consecutive years, the number of transfer applications dropped while the yield rates remained high.
- Although UNC System schools (UNC-C, NCSU, UNC-W, UNC-G and ASU) remained to be ECU's top competitors, none attracted >70 ECU accepted transfer students.
- Wake Tech, Pitt, Craven, Wayne, and Central Piedmont were the top five feeder schools.
- NCCCS is the primary transfer feeder for the UNC System. Transfer students are more likely to attend a UNC school close to their community college.
- 9.2% of accepted transfers who paid a tuition deposit and attended orientation did not enroll at ECU.
- Yield rates, student profiles, and major competitors vary across programs.
