Follow the steps below when reporting for the first time on a new outcome.

Educational Programs: Year 1 Reporting on a New Student Learning Outcome

- 1. Report the Actions Taken in the Current Reporting Year
 - Describe what was done during the academic year to address the outcome
- 2. Report Results
 - Summarize results from the means of assessment in the current reporting year
- 3. Report the Analysis of the Results
 - Identify an area or areas of student learning that can be improved in order to meet the stated outcome based on review of assessment results, student products and/or professional judgment
- 4. Report Actions Planned for Next Reporting Year
 - Describe the curricular or pedagogical actions planned to improve the identified area or areas of student learning in the next reporting year(s)

Support Units: Year 1 Reporting on a New Outcome

- 1. Report the Actions Taken in the Current Reporting Year
 - Describe the alignment of the outcome to the unit's mission and/or report what was done during the reporting year to address the outcome
- 2. Report Results
 - Summarize results from the means of assessment in the current reporting year
- 3. Report the Analysis of the Results
 - Identify an area or areas that can be improved in order to meet the stated outcome based on review of assessment results and/or professional judgment
- 4. Report Actions Planned for Next Reporting Year
 - Describe the actions planned to improve the identified area or areas in the next reporting year
