38% are in-state rural students

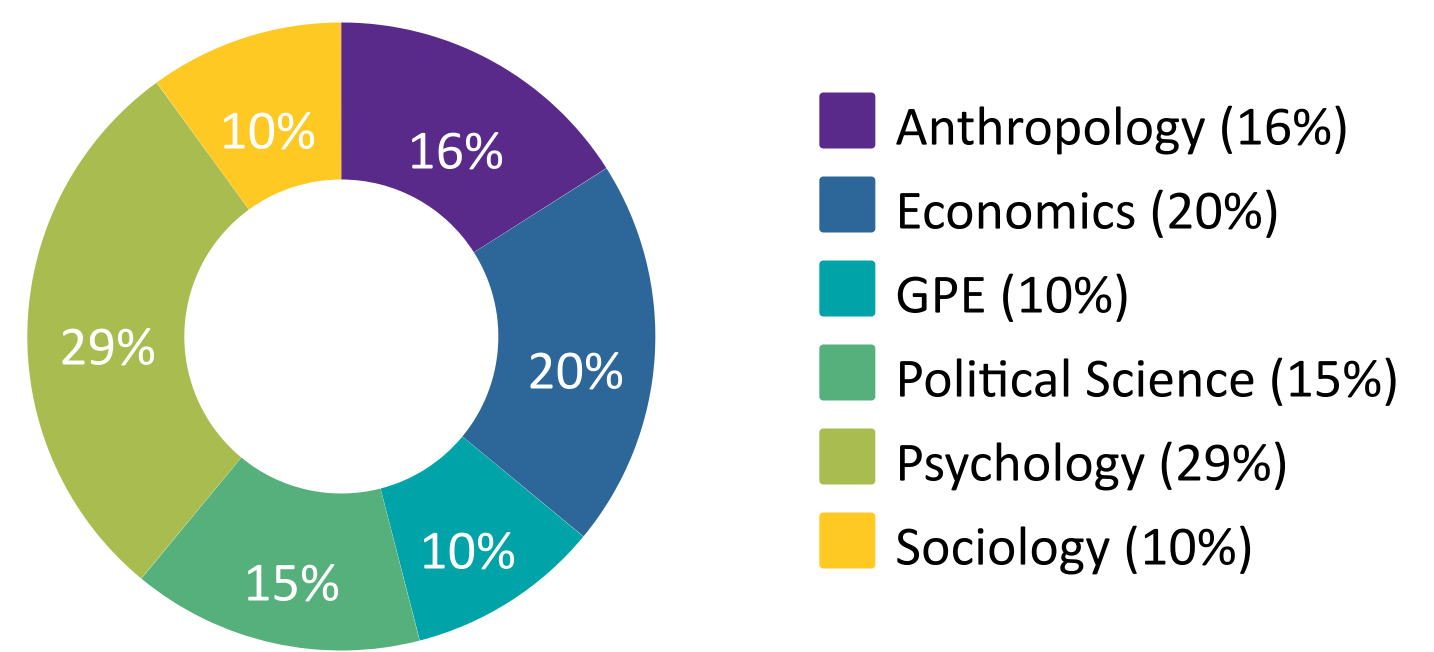


Average weighted HS GPA is 3.54

Average cumulative GPA is 2.77

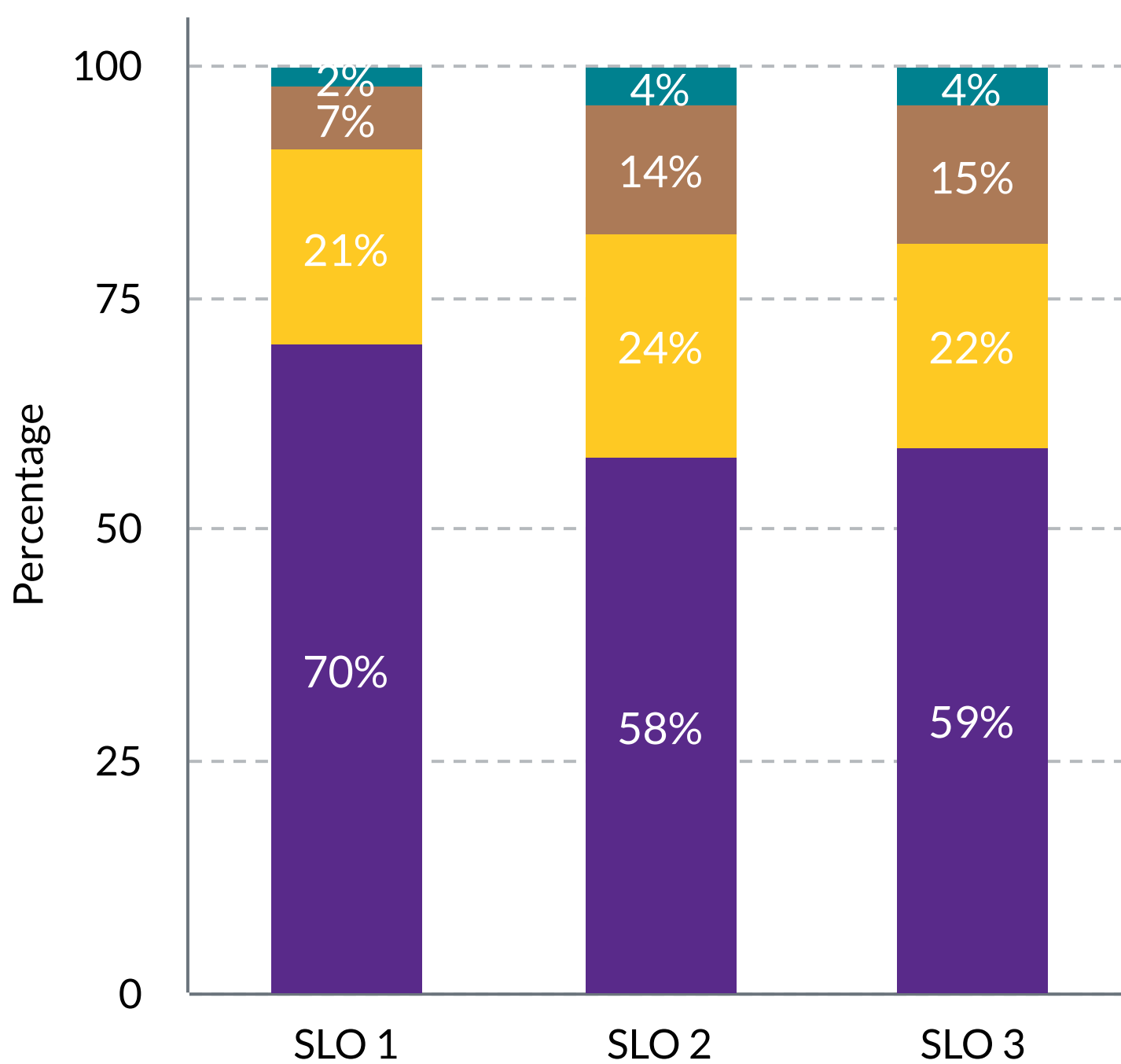

Assessment Sample by Department, N=1926



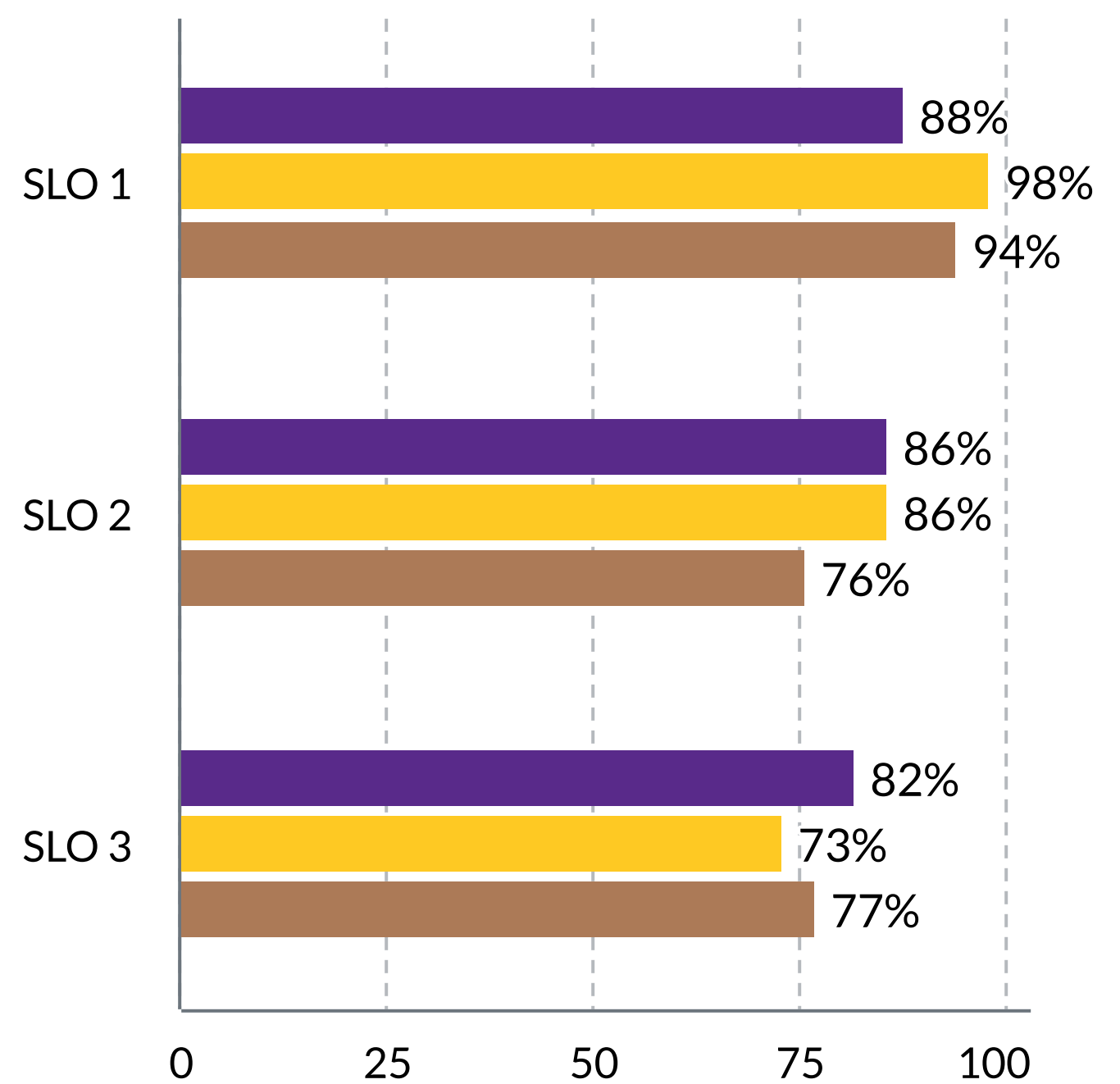
